LCM is excited to begin a New Year. We have completed last year's goal to buy new playground equipment. New toddler equipment has been purchased. Installation is still pending. Thank you for all your help!

The Preschool Bathroom renovation is on its final stretch. We are very excited to have extra facilities on the third floor.

As you know, LCM had obtained a \$26,000 *Early Learning Indiana Grant* to support this project. We are in the process of meeting the Paths to Quality criteria associated with this grant. 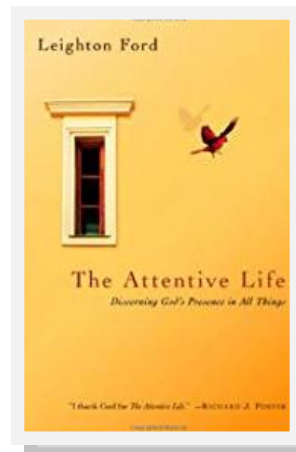
